HMA-v-Daanish Zabid – the murder of Glasgow teenager Kris Donald

HMA –v- DT – homicide of 15 year old schoolboy in a school gym hall by fellow pupil

HMA –v- Robert Jennings – Helensburgh triple murder of the Sharkey family in a house fire

HMA -v- Clive Carter – murder of pharmaceutical conference delegate at the SECC

HMA –v- Said Fadal – murder of Imam’s son in Edinburgh street shooting by Somali gang

HMA –v- Alice Ross – defence of oldest accused to face High Court trial in Scotland (aged 93) for causing death by dangerous driving

HMA-v- Angus Sinclair – Scotland’s first Double Jeopardy application and subsequent double murder trial known as the “World Ends Murders”

Shahid Ramzan –v- HMA – conducting appeal for the appellant convicted of Scotland’s largest VAT “carousel” or MTIC (Missing trader intra community) fraud

General Medical Council –v- DF –defending prominent doctor at Fitness to Practice Hearing

UK Anti-doping (on behalf of British Boxing Board of Control) –v- CW Jnr – defending professional boxer accused of breaching anti-doping regulations facing suspension of licence

CAS (Court of Arbitration for Sport, Switzerland) – assisting in advising American lawyers acting on behalf of prominent tennis player in an appeal against a doping ban

HMA –v- DS – alleged murder of Aberdeen schoolboy Bailey Gwynne while attending school. The accused was convicted of culpable homicide after trial.

HMA –v- Gary Witbey – alleged corporate conspiracy to defraud, in the

acquisition of Rangers FC by Craig Whyte from Sir David Murray. The accused (Craig Whyte's London-based lawyer in the acquisition) was acquitted of all charges.

HMA –v- Abdulkadir Cirik – UK's largest ever seizure of controlled drugs (£0.5 billion worth of cocaine) on a Turkish-crewed boat sailing between South America and mainland Europe. The accused (a crewman) was acquitted of all charges.

HMA –v- John Leatham – murder of 15 year old teenager, Paige Docherty
